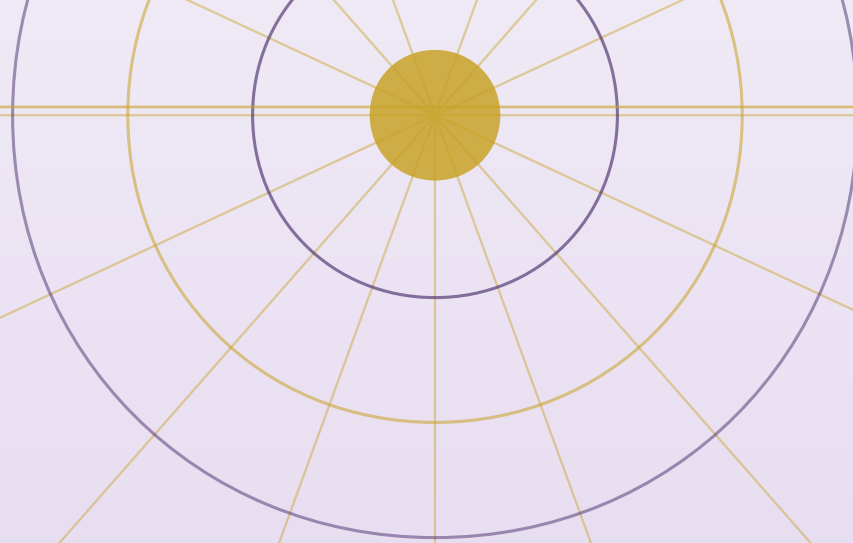




ASCENSION GATE III

THE INVITATION

Come Stand Where the Rock Itself Turns Red

Sedona's red-rock buttes and canyons need no esoteric framework to justify a visit — they are, in plain geological fact, some of the most striking sandstone formations in North America, stained the deep red of iron oxide and carved by millions of years of water and wind into shapes that draw millions of visitors every year regardless of what any of them believe.

In the tradition this document draws on, Sedona and the neighbouring Mogollon Rim carry the Solar Plexus Gate, sponsored by Helios and Vesta — Masters whose own sourced Retreat, the material is careful to note, is not of this Earth at all, but held within the physical Sun itself. This Gate's placement, in that account, is a function of active human participation rather than of the sponsors' own dwelling place.

Since 1994, the source material links this Gate by what it calls a crystalline pathway — the Templa Mar — to the Osiris Gate at Masada, by the Dead Sea, on the far side of the planet. Two deserts, two colours of stone, joined by a thread this document reports without claiming to verify.

THE LAND ITSELF

Red Rock and a Rim of Basalt

Sedona sits within a landscape of Permian-age Schnebly Hill sandstone, its deep red colour produced by iron oxide (hematite) coating the sand grains, later capped in places by darker basalt from more recent volcanic activity along the Mogollon Rim — the dramatic escarpment marking the southern edge of the Colorado Plateau.

The Mogollon Rim itself runs for roughly 320 kilometres across central Arizona, rising as much as 600 metres above the desert floor below it, a boundary between the high, forested plateau country to the north and the lower Sonoran desert basins to the south.

The region carries deep and continuous significance for the Yavapai and Apache peoples, among others, whose presence in this landscape long precedes the area's twentieth-century reputation as a destination for spiritual tourism — a reputation this document notes without either endorsing or dismissing it.

THE CHAKRA ITSELF

The Fire at the Body's Centre

In the classical yogic system, Manipura — the Solar Plexus chakra — sits in the upper abdomen, at the body's own natural centre of gravity, governing will, confidence, and personal power.

Associated with the element Fire and traditionally pictured in yellow, Manipura is the seat of transformation through will — the capacity to act, to assert oneself, to convert raw energy into deliberate action. A balanced Solar Plexus is associated with confidence without domination; an imbalanced one, with either timidity or aggression.

That the sponsors of this Gate, Helios and Vesta, are described as dwelling within the physical Sun itself makes for an especially direct correspondence: a chakra of inner fire, sponsored by beings whose own source material places them at the fire of the solar system itself.



THE TWELVE-POINT ASCENSION COLUMN

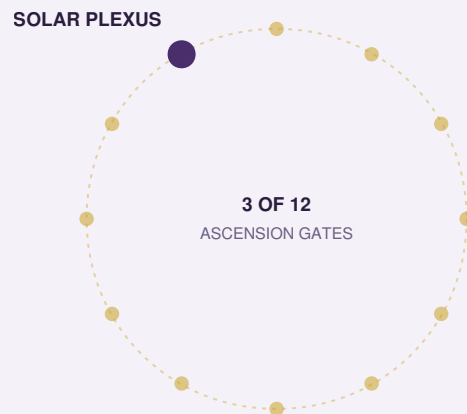
MANIPURA · THE SOLAR PLEXUS

THE ORIENTATION

Its Place Among the Twelve Gates

Among the Twelve, this Gate has been linked, since 1994 in the source material's account, to the Osiris Gate at the Dead Sea by a crystalline pathway called the Templa Mar.



AWAKENED

Sponsors Helios and Vesta are described in the source material as dwelling within the physical Sun itself, non-earthly — this Gate's earthly placement is a function of participation, not of the sponsors' own residence.

WATER & BREATH

Oak Creek running through Sedona's canyons, and high-desert air at roughly 1,300 metres elevation.

GROUND & SHELTER

Permian sandstone buttes and spires, some of the most photographed rock formations in North America.

FOOD & PROVISION

A high-desert agricultural tradition along Oak Creek, sustaining settlement in this region for centuries.

WORK & CRAFT

A substantial visitor and wellness economy built around the landscape's own striking geology.

WHAT THIS GROUND OFFERS

Rising Toward What a Community Needs

KINSHIP & BELONGING

Continuous Yavapai and Apache presence in this landscape, predating its modern reputation by many centuries.

CHILDREN & LEARNING

A living geology lesson in iron oxide staining and Colorado Plateau uplift, visible in every canyon wall.

CULTURE & CEREMONY

A landscape that has drawn spiritual seekers of many traditions for generations, alongside its indigenous history.

REST & RENEWAL

Dramatic red-rock vistas at sunrise and sunset, among the most visually striking in North America.

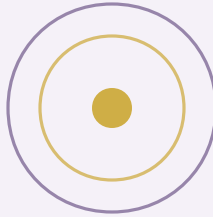
VISION & CALLING

Held, in the framework offered here, as a Gate of active fire — will and confidence, sponsored from the Sun itself.

A Pathway Between Two Deserts

The Templa Mar, linking this Gate to the Osiris Gate at the Dead Sea since 1994 in the source material's account, is reported here as belonging to that tradition specifically — a claimed energetic connection between two very different desert landscapes on opposite sides of the planet.

This document holds that claim distinct from Sedona's own well-documented geology and its long, continuous indigenous history, both of which stand entirely on their own regardless of any esoteric framework laid over them.



A THRESHOLD, NOT A DESTINATION

None of this replaces standing on the ground itself. A Gate is not a monument and not a holiday stop — it is a place already at work, quietly, holding one point of the human body's own architecture open against the sky.

Whatever draws you here — red rock stained by iron across millions of years, or the quieter claim of a crystalline thread to a desert on the far side of the Earth — the invitation is the same one this whole field of Gates extends.

SEDONA & THE MOGOLLON RIM

34.8697° N, 111.7610° W · Elevation approx. 1,320 m (4,330 ft)

Permian-age red sandstone formations at the southern edge of the Colorado Plateau, central Arizona.

THE TEMPLA MAR

A crystalline pathway named in the source material, linking this Gate to the Osiris Gate at Masada and the Dead Sea since 1994.

REGIONAL ACCESS

Sedona, Coconino and Yavapai counties, Arizona; the Mogollon Rim extends east along the Coconino National Forest boundary.

SPONSOR & COSMIC QUALITY

Gate 3 of Twelve · Helios and Vesta · Awakened
