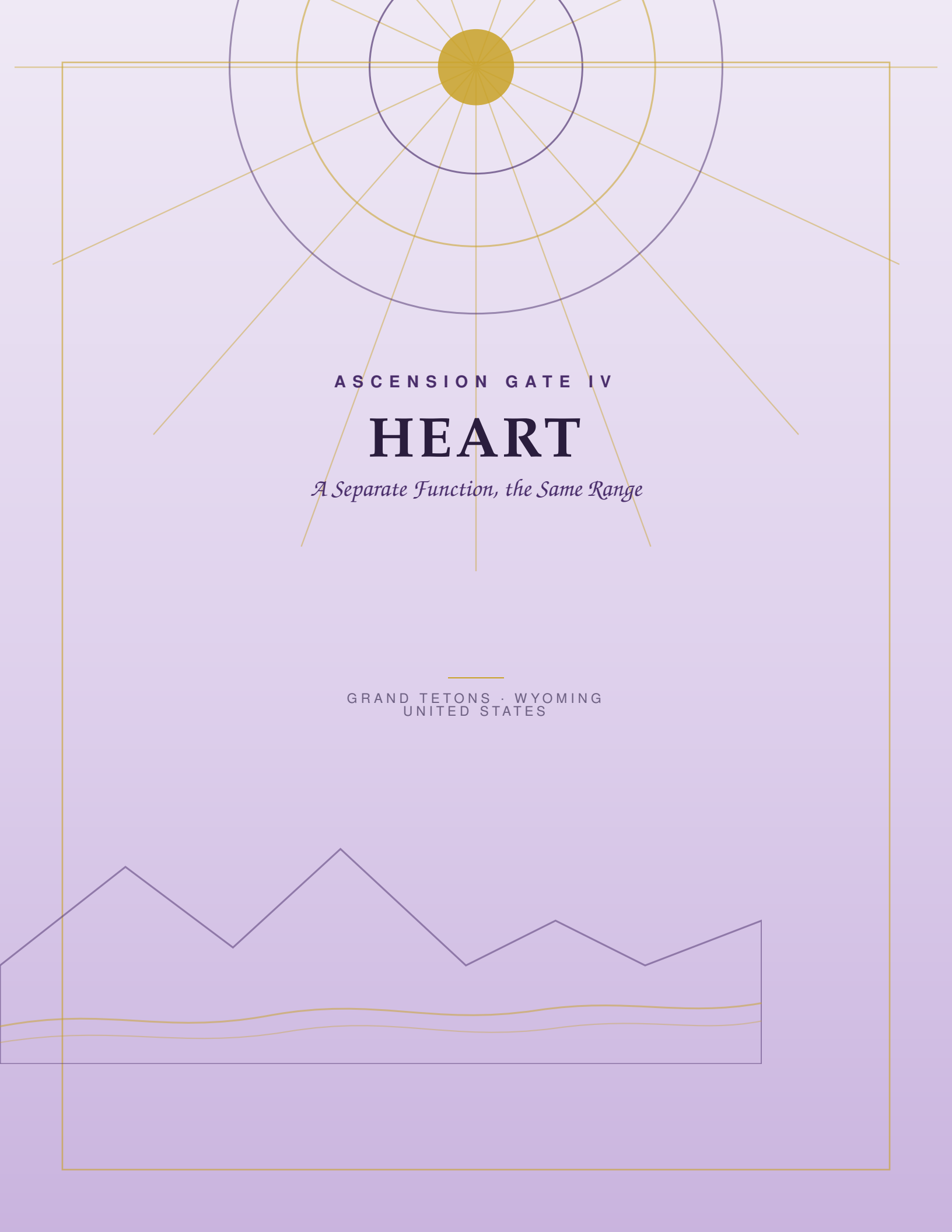

THE INVITATION

Come Stand Beneath the Range That Rises Without Foothills

The Teton Range does something almost no other mountain range in North America does: it rises directly from a flat valley floor with no foothills to soften the transition, granite peaks reaching over 2,100 metres of sheer vertical relief in a single, uninterrupted rise. Few landscapes anywhere state their scale as plainly.

In the framework this document draws on, this range already holds one major role — the Royal Teton Retreat, sourced as the dwelling place of St Germain, Lord Lanto, Confucius, and Mighty Victory. This document is careful to state that the Heart Ascension Gate is a separate function, held at the same range, not a restatement of that Retreat's own role.

The Gate's sponsors, Maha Ouranus and the Seven Mighty Consorts, are themselves described as dwelling 'above the sidereal heavens' — non-earthly, in the same pattern already noted for Helios and Vesta at the Solar Plexus Gate. This document holds both facts — the shared range, the non-earthly sponsorship — plainly and without conflating them.

THE LAND ITSELF

A Range With No Foothills

The Teton Range rises abruptly from the floor of Jackson Hole, Wyoming, with almost no foothill transition — Grand Teton itself reaches 4,199 metres, one of the youngest mountain ranges in the Rockies, still actively uplifting along the Teton Fault at its base even as glaciers and rivers continue to carve it.

The valley floor below, Jackson Hole, sits at roughly 1,900 metres, meaning the range's visible vertical relief — over 2,100 metres in places — is achieved in a single dramatic rise, a geological rarity that makes the Tetons among the most photographed mountains in the United States.

This document deliberately places this Gate's imagery at the valley floor rather than the summit — already the setting most associated with the Royal Teton Retreat in the wider source material — rather than attempting to claim the peak itself for a separate function.

THE CHAKRA ITSELF

The Heart's Own Wide Room

In the classical yogic system, Anahata — the Heart chakra — sits at the centre of the chest, the midpoint of the whole chakra column, where the lower, body-centred chakras meet the upper, mind-centred ones.

Associated with the element Air and traditionally pictured in green, Anahata governs love, compassion, and connection — the capacity to hold both self and other without collapsing the distance between them. It is often described as the chakra where healing work is most directly felt.

A range that rises without foothills — nothing gradual, nothing hedging the scale of what is in front of you — offers, this document suggests, its own kind of correspondence to a chakra whose whole function is directness: the heart does not ease into feeling by degrees.



THE TWELVE-POINT ASCENSION COLUMN

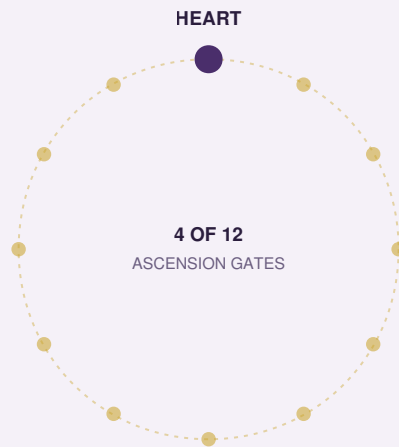
ANAHATA · THE HEART

Element: Air · Colour: Green · Theme: Love, Compassion, Connection

THE ORIENTATION

Its Place Among the Twelve Gates

Among the Twelve, this Gate sits at the Teton Range, Wyoming — a separate function from the Royal Teton Retreat already sourced at the same mountains, sponsored by beings whose own dwelling is described as non-earthly.



AWAKENED

This document holds the Gate function and the Retreat function as distinct, both located at the same range, per the source material's own careful separation of the two.

WHAT THIS GROUND OFFERS

Beginning With What a Body Needs

WATER & BREATH

Glacier-fed rivers and lakes at the base of the range, and clean alpine air at high elevation.

GROUND & SHELTER

Young granite peaks, still actively uplifting along the Teton Fault.

FOOD & PROVISION

Jackson Hole's ranching and, more recently, tourism economy, sustained by the valley's rivers and grassland.

WORK & CRAFT

A mountaineering and conservation tradition centred on Grand Teton National Park.

WHAT THIS GROUND OFFERS

Rising Toward What a Community Needs

KINSHIP & BELONGING

A valley community organised, quite literally, around what everyone there can see rising above them without interruption.

CHILDREN & LEARNING

A rare, legible lesson in active mountain-building — fault, uplift, and glacier all visibly at work.

CULTURE & CEREMONY

Shoshone and other indigenous traditions holding deep relationship with this valley, predating the park by many centuries.

REST & RENEWAL

A valley floor from which the whole range is visible at once — an unusually direct, ungraded encounter with scale.

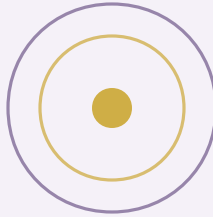
VISION & CALLING

Held, in the framework offered here, as a Gate of direct connection — heart to heart, range to valley, without foothills between.

Two Functions, One Range

The Royal Teton Retreat's sourcing as the dwelling place of St Germain, Lord Lanto, Confucius, and Mighty Victory is among the more widely repeated claims in this wider esoteric tradition; this document treats it as already established elsewhere and does not restate it as evidence for the Heart Gate specifically.

The Heart Gate itself, sponsored by Maha Ouranus and the Seven Mighty Consorts from a dwelling described as 'above the sidereal heavens,' is offered here as its own separate claim, held at the same physical range by the source material's own account rather than by any independent corroboration this document can offer.



A THRESHOLD, NOT A DESTINATION

None of this replaces standing on the ground itself. A Gate is not a monument and not a holiday stop — it is a place already at work, quietly, holding one point of the human body's own architecture open against the sky.

Whatever draws you here — a mountain range that rises without easing into its own scale, or the quieter claim of a heart-centred threshold held at its base — the invitation is the same one this whole field of Gates extends.

Ascension Gate IV of the Twelve · the Teton Range, Wyoming, United States.

THE TETON RANGE

43.7904° N, 110.8021° W · Grand Teton 4,199 m (13,775 ft)

A young, actively uplifting range rising directly from the floor of Jackson Hole with minimal foothill transition.

A SEPARATE FUNCTION

The Royal Teton Retreat (St Germain, Lord Lanto, Confucius, Mighty Victory) is already sourced at this range; the Heart Gate is held here as a distinct, separate function.

REGIONAL ACCESS

Grand Teton National Park, Teton County, Wyoming; the town of Jackson lies just south of the park.

SPONSOR & COSMIC QUALITY

Gate 4 of Twelve · Maha Ouranus & the Seven Mighty Consorts · Awakened
Eternal Life
