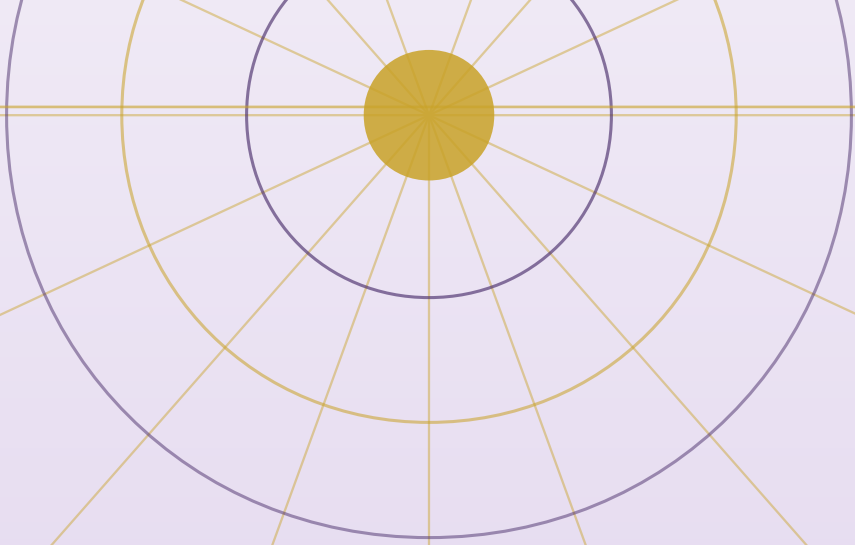

THE INVITATION

Come Stand in the Valley of the Golden Disc

The San Luis Valley is one of the largest alpine valleys on Earth, a vast high-desert basin ringed by the Sangre de Cristo and San Juan mountain ranges, its small town of Crestone having become, over recent decades, home to an unusually dense concentration of retreat centres representing traditions from Zen Buddhism to Carmelite Christianity to Hindu ashram practice.

In the framework this document draws on, this Gate is named 'Auramur' in the Ascension Temple Triad, and the source material states plainly that this Crown Gate 'links this Valley of the Golden Disc with Tibet and Great Britain' — a three-way connection this document reports as the source states it.

This is also the site of the same Buehler correction noted at Rennes-le-Château: William Buehler's 1992 Crestone-area field mission was commissioned within the source's own Thoth lineage, not independent of it — a distinction this document holds consistently wherever his work is named.

THE LAND ITSELF

A Valley the Size of a Small Country

The San Luis Valley spans roughly 200 kilometres north to south, sitting at an average elevation above 2,300 metres between the Sangre de Cristo range to the east and the San Juan Mountains to the west — one of the largest high-altitude desert valleys in the world.

Crestone, at the valley's northeastern edge beneath the Sangre de Cristo peaks, has since the late twentieth century become home to dozens of spiritual centres and retreats spanning an unusually wide range of traditions, a concentration that developed organically rather than through any single coordinated plan.

The valley's water table sits unusually close to the surface in places, feeding artesian wells and wetlands that stand out sharply against the surrounding high desert — a genuine hydrological rarity that has fed its own layer of local legend, alongside the area's well-documented spiritual diversity.

THE CHAKRA ITSELF

The Crown's Open Canopy

In the classical yogic system, Sahasrara — the Crown chakra — sits at the top of the head, the highest of the seven classical chakras, governing spiritual connection and the sense of unity beyond the individual self.

Traditionally pictured in violet or white and associated with pure consciousness rather than any single element, Sahasrara is where the chakra system opens outward past the personal self — the point most associated, across traditions, with transcendence, unity, and direct spiritual experience.

A valley that has organically drawn dozens of distinct spiritual traditions into close proximity, each pursuing the same underlying aim of transcendence by different routes, offers a striking real-world correspondence to a chakra defined precisely by that kind of unity-beyond-difference.



THE TWELVE-POINT ASCENSION COLUMN

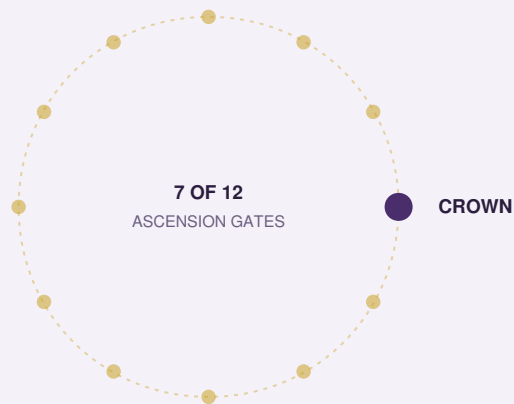
SAHASRARA · THE CROWN

Element: Pure Consciousness · Colour: Violet/White · Theme: Unity, Transcendence, Connection

THE ORIENTATION

Its Place Among the Twelve Gates

Among the Twelve, this Gate is named 'Auramur' in the Ascension Temple Triad; the source material states it links this valley with Tibet and Great Britain.



AWAKENED

Beginning With What a Body Needs

WATER & BREATH

Artesian wells and wetlands rising unusually close to the surface across an otherwise arid high-desert valley.

GROUND & SHELTER

A vast alpine basin ringed by two major mountain ranges, among the largest such valleys on Earth.

FOOD & PROVISION

High-altitude agriculture across the valley floor, drawing on the region's unusual water table.

WORK & CRAFT

Dozens of retreat centres and spiritual communities, each maintaining its own tradition's practices and grounds.

WHAT THIS GROUND OFFERS

Rising Toward What a Community Needs

KINSHIP & BELONGING

A genuinely interfaith community, with Buddhist, Christian, Hindu, and other traditions coexisting in close geographic proximity.

CHILDREN & LEARNING

A living comparative-religion education, simply by visiting the range of centres within a few miles of one small town.

CULTURE & CEREMONY

Practice traditions spanning multiple continents and centuries, each maintained fully and separately rather than blended.

REST & RENEWAL

Wide, high-desert silence beneath two mountain ranges, a landscape many residents describe as unusually conducive to contemplative life.

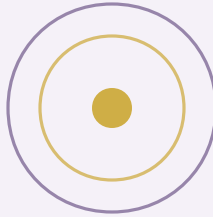
VISION & CALLING

Held, in the framework offered here, as 'Auramur' — a Crown-point linking this valley to Tibet and Great Britain.

The claim that this Gate links the San Luis Valley to Tibet and Great Britain is offered here exactly as the source material states it — a structural claim within the Ascension Temple Triad this document reports rather than independently verifies.

What stands independent of that claim is the valley's own demonstrated history: a genuine, organically formed concentration of contemplative traditions from across the world, already doing in practice what a Crown chakra is said to represent in principle.

REGIONAL ACCESS

Crestone, Saguache County, Colorado, at the valley's northeastern edge beneath the Sangre de Cristo range.
