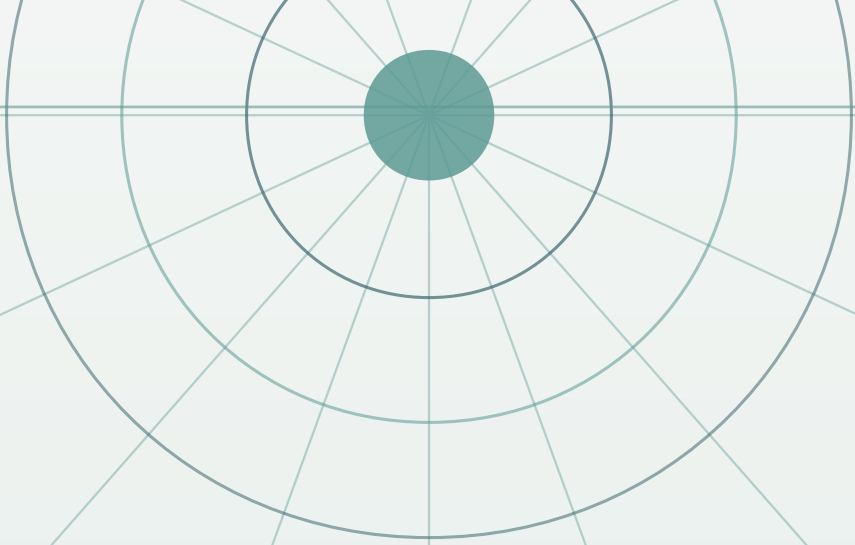


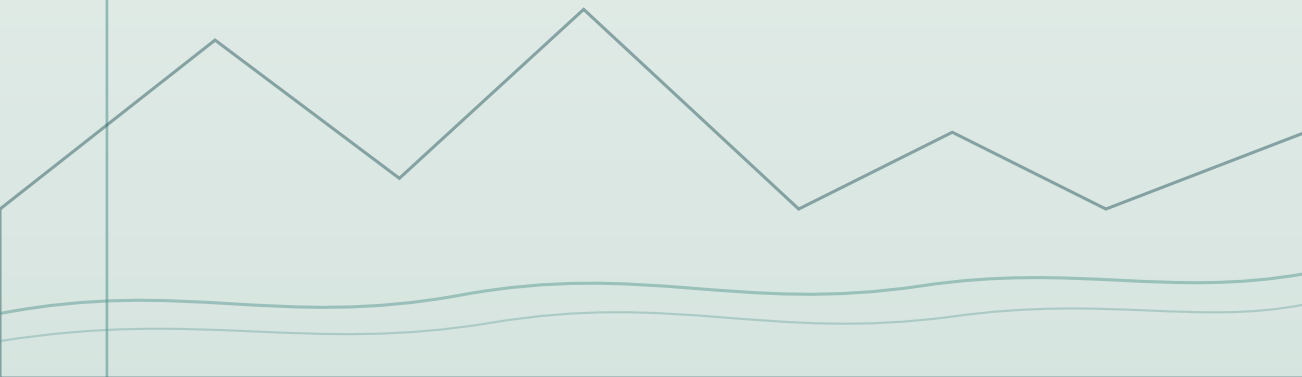

THE INVITATION

Come Stand Where the Land Runs Out

Of the twelve Satellites in this field, this is the one closest to home — barely four hundred miles from the Sun Disc's own ground, the nearest point where the radiation this whole field carries first meets open water.

Galveston is a barrier island: a long, low strip of sand holding the line between the mainland and the Gulf, a place that has rebuilt itself more than once after storms tried to take it, and a working port city that has carried Texas's trade with the wider world for well over a century.

It is also, plainly and specifically, the named site of a real gathering: the Galveston “Cosmic Trigger” event, held at Moody Gardens, where James Tyberonn presented directly on the Crystalline Age, the Pyramids, and the Cosmic Trigger itself — a teaching, not a stone, but a genuine, locatable point of corroboration all the same.

THE LAND ITSELF

A Barrier Island That Keeps Rebuilding Itself

Galveston sits on a narrow barrier island along the Texas Gulf Coast, its bay and wetlands separating the open Gulf from the mainland. The city built its fortune on maritime trade, and after the catastrophic 1900 hurricane — still the deadliest natural disaster in U.S. history — it engineered a seventeen-foot seawall and physically raised much of the city's grade to hold its ground against the water it lives beside.

Moody Gardens, a real, still-operating venue on the island, hosted the Galveston “Cosmic Trigger” gathering, where James Tyberonn delivered a presentation titled “Crystalline Age, Pyramids & The Cosmic Trigger” from the hotel's Ocean View Room. This is a different kind of corroboration than the geological or archaeological record offered for some of the other Satellites in this field — an actual named teaching event, at an actual named venue, on this exact stretch of coast — and it is stated here as exactly that.

The Gulf itself, beyond the island's outer beach, is the nearest open ocean to the Sun Disc's own ground in Arkansas — the first place the land simply stops and the water begins.

THE ORIENTATION

A Line Back to the Source

From the Sun Disc's ground in Arkansas, this Satellite sits to the south-southwest — by far the closest of the twelve, barely four hundred miles distant.



This Satellite is corroborated not by geology but by a named event: the Galveston Cosmic Trigger gathering at Moody Gardens, where James Tyberonn presented directly on this material. It is offered here honestly as that kind of evidence — a real teaching occasion, rather than a natural or archaeological formation.

Beginning With What a Body Needs

WATER & BREATH

The Gulf itself, and the bay and wetlands sheltered behind the barrier island.

GROUND & SHELTER

A barrier island rebuilt, engineered, and raised by its own people after the deadliest storm in U.S. history — proof of a place that holds its ground.

FOOD & PROVISION

Gulf fisheries and a long shrimping and maritime-trade heritage.

WORK & CRAFT

A working port city carrying Texas's trade with the world for well over a century.

WHAT THIS GROUND OFFERS

Rising Toward What a Community Needs

KINSHIP & BELONGING

A community with a documented history of rebuilding itself together after catastrophe, more than once.

CHILDREN & LEARNING

Moody Gardens itself — an active, public teaching and gathering venue, open on this exact ground.

CULTURE & CEREMONY

The Galveston Cosmic Trigger gathering, a real, named teaching event held directly on this Satellite's ground.

REST & RENEWAL

Open Gulf horizon and sea air, the first true edge of the continent reached from the Sun Disc.

VISION & CALLING

The nearest point in this whole field of twelve where the land simply gives way to open water — a literal and figurative edge.

A Named Gathering, Not a Named Stone

Where several of the other Satellites in this field carry geological or archaeological corroboration, this one carries something different and equally real: a specific, locatable teaching event. James Tyberonn presented “Crystalline Age, Pyramids & The Cosmic Trigger” at Moody Gardens on this exact stretch of Gulf coast — named here as precisely what it is, an occasion of transmission rather than a formation in stone.

That distinction matters, and this document draws it deliberately: a Satellite's corroboration can be geological, archaeological, or simply the record of a teaching having been given, in person, on that exact ground. Galveston's is the third kind.



A RECEIVING POINT, NOT A DESTINATION

None of this replaces standing on the ground itself. A Satellite is not a monument and not a holiday stop — it is a place already at work, quietly, carrying what the Sun Disc radiates outward into the land and the people around it.

Whatever draws you here — the nearest edge of open water to the Sun Disc itself, a barrier island that has rebuilt itself more than once, or the record of a teaching once given on this exact ground — the invitation is the same one this whole field of Satellites extends.

Specifications & Coordinates

Satellite 08 of the Arkansas Sun Disc · Galveston, Texas, United States — the Gulf of Mexico near Moody Gardens.

THE WATER — GULF OF MEXICO, OFF GALVESTON

29.30° N, 94.80° W

Barrier island coast, Galveston, Texas, on the Gulf of Mexico; nearest Satellite to the Sun Disc reference point.

CORROBORATION

Named as one of two primary receiving points of the Cosmic Trigger, corroborated by the Galveston Cosmic Trigger gathering at Moody Gardens, featuring a presentation by James Tyberonn.

REGIONAL ACCESS

Galveston Island, Texas, via Interstate 45 from Houston; Moody Gardens is a public attraction and hotel/convention venue on the island.

RELATION TO THE SUN DISC

Bearing 200.1° from Pinnacle Mountain, Arkansas · 406 miles (654 km)

Great-circle bearing and distance computed from the Sun Disc reference point (34.8414° N, 92.4858° W) to the coordinate given above.

Note: this document offers orientation, not survey. The coordinates above mark the general Gulf-side location, not a specific parcel boundary.
