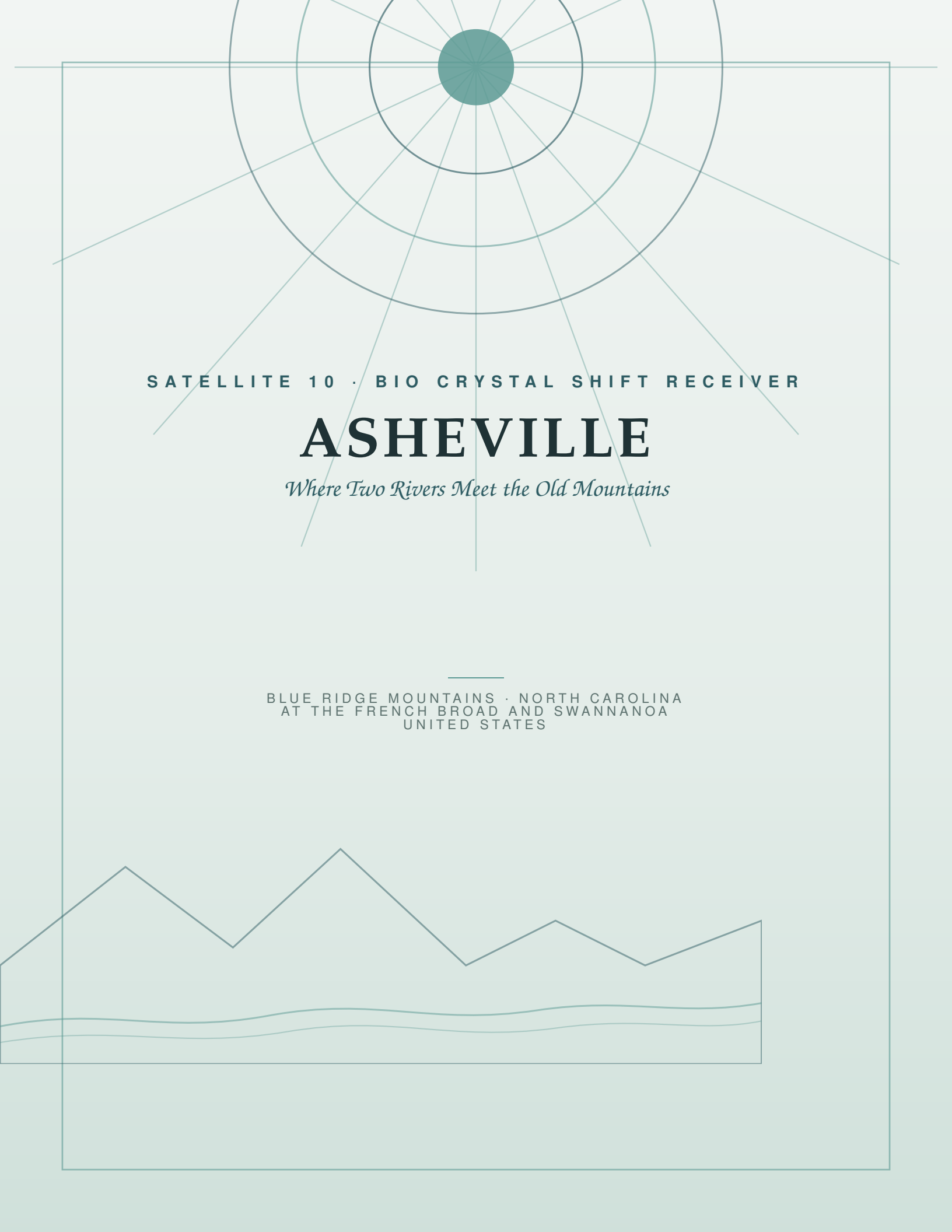

THE INVITATION

Come Stand Where the Rivers Join

Two rivers meet here — the French Broad and the Swannanoa — inside some of the oldest mountains on the planet, rock in places dated well over a billion years, folded up long before almost anything else on this continent took its current shape.

It is a confluence, the same shape of ground the Sun Disc's own site holds in Arkansas: a summit and a joining of waters, echoed here on a different range eight hundred miles to the east.

The Cherokee, the Ani-Yvwiya — the Real People — have called these mountains home for some eleven thousand years, and their descendants continue as the Eastern Band of Cherokee, still present on the Qualla Boundary just fifty-one miles from this exact confluence.

THE LAND ITSELF

Some of the Oldest Rock on the Continent

Asheville sits at the junction of the French Broad and Swannanoa rivers, in the Blue Ridge Mountains — a range extending across eight states from Pennsylvania to Georgia, among the oldest and most geologically complex mountains on Earth. Nearby Mount Mitchell, at 6,684 feet, is the highest point in North Carolina and the highest peak east of the Mississippi River; some of its rock formations are dated at over a billion years old.

The Appalachian range itself was built between roughly 400 and 600 million years ago. This exact valley was, for a very long time before European settlement, Cherokee hunting ground, part of a homeland the Cherokee — Ani-Yvwiya, the Real People — have held for some eleven thousand years. Their Great Warrior Path once threaded these river valleys, later becoming a foundation for the region's major trade routes.

Today the Eastern Band of Cherokee continues on the Qualla Boundary, just 51 miles from downtown Asheville — an unbroken continuity of presence stretching from eleven millennia ago to the present morning.

THE ORIENTATION

A Line Back to the Source

From the Sun Disc's ground in Arkansas, this Satellite sits almost due east, in the Blue Ridge Mountains of western North Carolina.



Named in the primary source material and separately corroborated in the Bio Crystal Shift Part 3 receiver-station list — an independent line of testimony beyond the original Arkansas Crystalline Tours naming.

WHAT THIS GROUND OFFERS

Beginning With What a Body Needs

WATER & BREATH

Two living rivers meeting directly in the heart of the city, and clean mountain air drawn down from some of the oldest ridgelines on the continent.

GROUND & SHELTER

Bedrock over a billion years old in places, folded into the Blue Ridge across hundreds of millions of years.

FOOD & PROVISION

Fertile river-valley agriculture and a long tradition of mountain foodways.

WORK & CRAFT

A living, present-day tradition of craft and making — Asheville remains one of the region's true centers of working artisans.

WHAT THIS GROUND OFFERS

Rising Toward What a Community Needs

KINSHIP & BELONGING

A confluence, in the most literal sense — the same shape of gathering ground the Sun Disc itself holds in Arkansas, echoed here on a different range.

CHILDREN & LEARNING

Rivers and billion-year mountains together as a living classroom in deep time.

CULTURE & CEREMONY

Eleven thousand years of continuous Cherokee presence, and the Great Warrior Path that once threaded these exact valleys.

REST & RENEWAL

Cool mountain air and river sound, in a valley shaped for gathering rather than passing through.

VISION & CALLING

Ridge views across some of the oldest and most complex geological formations on Earth.

A Second, Independent Naming

Asheville's place in this field rests on more than a single source: named in the primary Arkansas Crystalline Tours material, it is also corroborated separately in the Bio Crystal Shift Part 3 receiver-station list — two independent lines of testimony naming the same ground as a genuine receiving point.

The confluence itself carries its own quiet resonance with the Sun Disc's own site: a summit and a joining of two rivers, the very shape this whole field of work keeps returning to, found again eight hundred miles to the east in some of the oldest mountains on the continent.



A RECEIVING POINT, NOT A DESTINATION

None of this replaces standing on the ground itself. A Satellite is not a monument and not a holiday stop — it is a place already at work, quietly, carrying what the Sun Disc radiates outward into the land and the people around it.

Whatever draws you here — the meeting of two rivers, eleven thousand years of continuous Cherokee presence, or the second independent naming that confirms this ground — the invitation is the same one this whole field of Satellites extends.

Specifications & Coordinates

Satellite 10 of the Arkansas Sun Disc · Asheville, North Carolina, United States.

THE CONFLUENCE — ASHEVILLE

35.60° N, 82.55° W

Junction of the French Broad and Swannanoa Rivers, Blue Ridge Mountains, western North Carolina. Mount Mitchell (6,684 ft), the highest peak east of the Mississippi, stands nearby.

CORROBORATION

Named in the primary source and separately corroborated in the Bio Crystal Shift Part 3 receiver-station list — an independent line of confirmation.

REGIONAL ACCESS

Buncombe County, western North Carolina; the Eastern Band of Cherokee's Qualla Boundary lies approx. 51 miles to the west.

RELATION TO THE SUN DISC

Bearing 81.8° from Pinnacle Mountain, Arkansas · 563 miles (906 km)

Great-circle bearing and distance computed from the Sun Disc reference point (34.8414° N, 92.4858° W) to the coordinate given above.

Note: this document offers orientation, not survey. The coordinates above mark the named confluence, not a specific parcel boundary.
