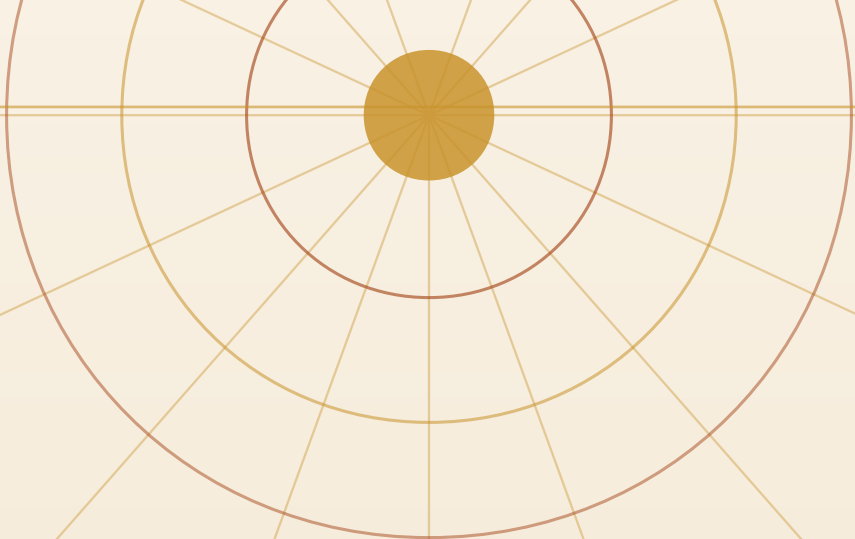

## THE INVITATION

# Come Stand Beneath Africa's Roof

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**K**ilimanjaro is the tallest freestanding mountain on Earth — rising alone from the East African plain rather than as part of a connected range, its snow-capped summit visible from a hundred miles away across the savanna. Almost 6,000 metres of vertical rise, from tropical farmland at its base to near-Arctic ice at its crown, all within a single day's walk in ecological terms even though the climb itself takes days.

In the Earth-Keeper tradition drawn on here, Kilimanjaro is held as an actively transducing Sun Disc — not a dormant or symbolic point but one described as continuously working. Kryon material separately names it a Null point, paired with the Yucatán Peninsula on the far side of the Atlantic — a correspondence this document finds independently strengthened by an unrelated source: Edgar Cayce's trance readings, decades earlier, which named the Yucatán as a repository of Atlantean memory with no reference to Kilimanjaro at all.

Two threads, developed independently — Kryon's paired Null points and Cayce's much earlier trance material — converge on the same distant peninsula as Kilimanjaro's counterpart. In the framework this document draws on, that convergence is named among the strongest correspondences found anywhere across the Twelve.

## Africa's Tallest, Standing Alone

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At 5,895 metres, Kilimanjaro is both the highest peak in Africa and the tallest freestanding mountain in the world — a dormant stratovolcano rising directly from the Tanzanian plain rather than from a mountain range, with a base diameter of roughly 60 kilometres. It last had significant volcanic activity around 150,000 to 200,000 years ago, though minor gas emissions persist from its Kibo crater.

The mountain hosts five distinct ecological zones on its single ascent — cultivated farmland, montane rainforest, moorland, alpine desert, and glacial summit — a vertical journey through nearly every climate on Earth compressed into one mountainside. Its equatorial glaciers, among the very few remaining anywhere near the equator, have retreated significantly over the past century, a fact widely cited in climate research.

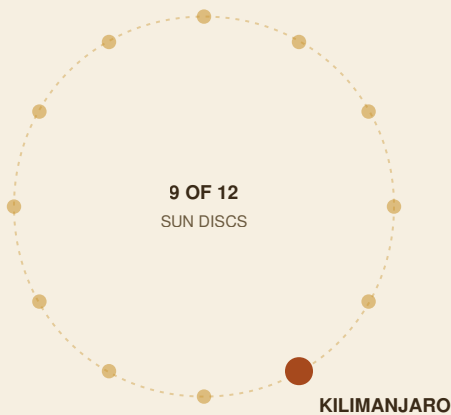
The Yucatán Peninsula, Kilimanjaro's named counterpart in this framework, carries its own deep and independently documented history: the heartland of Classic Maya civilization, and — decades before any of the material discussed here — the specific location Edgar Cayce's early-twentieth-century trance readings named as a place where memory of Atlantis was said to be preserved, developed with no reference to any Sun Disc material.

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Among the Twelve, Kilimanjaro is held as an actively transducing Sun Disc, paired as a Null point with the Yucatán Peninsula — a correspondence this document finds independently reinforced by Edgar Cayce's much earlier, separately developed trance material naming the Yucatán as an Atlantean memory repository.



This is offered here as one of the strongest correspondences found among the Twelve, precisely because its two supporting threads — Kryon's Null-point mapping and Cayce's decades-earlier trance readings — were developed independently of one another.

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### KINSHIP & BELONGING

A mountain visible for a hundred miles in every direction — a shared landmark orienting entire regions of East Africa around one point.

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### CHILDREN & LEARNING

A single ascent that teaches, physically, nearly every climate zone on Earth — a geography lesson walked rather than read.

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### CULTURE & CEREMONY

Chagga agricultural and cultural tradition, rooted in the mountain's fertile lower slopes for centuries.

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### REST & RENEWAL

The rare experience of standing above the clouds on the equator, snow and ice within sight of tropical savanna far below.

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### VISION & CALLING

Held, in the framework offered here, as one of the strongest of all twelve correspondences — a mountain and a distant peninsula, named as counterparts by two unrelated sources.

## Two Sources, One Correspondence

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Kryon material's Null-point pairing of Kilimanjaro and the Yucatán, and Edgar Cayce's early-twentieth-century trance readings naming the Yucatán as a place of preserved Atlantean memory, were developed decades apart, through entirely different methods, with no indication either source drew on the other. Their independent convergence on the same distant peninsula is, in the tradition this document draws from, treated as unusually significant precisely because of that independence.

The Earth-Keeper tradition's description of Kilimanjaro as an actively transducing Sun Disc — ongoing work rather than dormant potential — is offered here as belonging to that same body of material, distinct from, though resonant with, the mountain's independently verified ecological and cultural significance.

None of this replaces standing on the ground itself. A Sun Disc is not a monument and not a holiday stop — it is a place already at work, quietly, radiating outward into the land, the Satellites that will one day surround it, and the people who come looking.

Whatever draws you here — the tallest freestanding mountain on Earth, or the quiet correspondence linking it to a distant peninsula by two unrelated paths — the invitation is the same one this whole field of Sun Discs extends.

# Specifications & Coordinates

Sun Disc IX of the Twelve · Mount Kilimanjaro, Tanzania — paired, in this framework, with the Yucatán Peninsula.

### THE MOUNTAIN

3.0674° S, 37.3556° E · Elevation 5,895 m (19,341 ft)

The tallest freestanding mountain in the world and the highest peak in Africa; a dormant stratovolcano with five distinct ecological zones on its single ascent.

### THE YUCATÁN PAIRING

Named as Kilimanjaro's Null-point counterpart in Kryon material; independently, Edgar Cayce's early-20th-century trance readings named the Yucatán as a repository of Atlantean memory, developed with no reference to Kilimanjaro.

### REGIONAL ACCESS

Kilimanjaro National Park, northern Tanzania; nearest major town Moshi. A UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1987.
