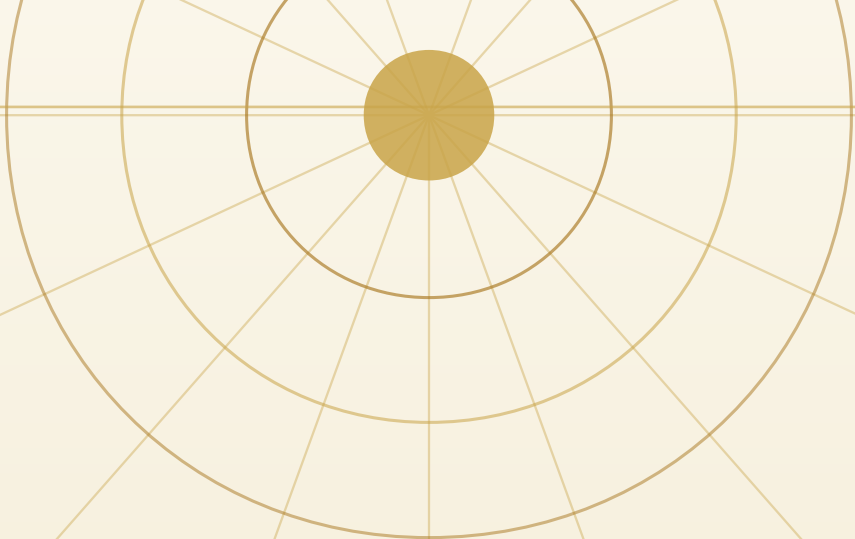




AREA V OF ELEVEN · WHERE THREE SEPARATE REGISTERS MEET

HAWAIIAN ISLANDS

The One Area Where Three Separate Registers Point to the Same Ground

Three Systems, Kept Deliberately Apart

Area Five is the only one of the eleven outer Areas that overlaps, in this Wheel's own wider register, with both a Sun Disc Satellite and an Ascension Gate: Satellite I and the Base or Root Gate both land in Hawai'i, near the summit of Mauna Kea. Its fuller unveiling — Mauna a Wākea, Lake Waiāu, the piko tradition — is told on those pages rather than repeated in full here.

What belongs to this document is narrower and more exacting: as an Artificial Time Warp Area, Hawai'i is tested using its own official geographic centre, off Maui, not the Mauna Kea summit the other two systems name. That separation is deliberate. No Gate or Sun Disc coordinate is imported into the Hurtak test; each architecture is kept independent until a later comparison is explicitly justified.

The result is a document about a different question than the Satellite or Gate pages ask: not whether this ground is sacred by two other measures, but whether the source material's own eastward instruction lands anywhere near it, tested on its own terms.

An Archipelago Tested at Its Own Centre

Hawai'i's official geographic centre sits offshore of Maui, a cartographic convention calculated from the state's full island chain rather than any single peak or shoreline. A secondary named-feature point within the archipelago is tested alongside it as a sensitivity check, and the two independent controls return closely matching results — a stronger registration, in Book I's own assessment, than either control would offer alone.

This is a different kind of Hawaiian geography than Mauna Kea's summit — less a single storied place than the chain's own balance point, useful precisely because it is a reproducible convention rather than a transmitted or energetic centre claimed for itself.

The wider archipelago's volcanic origin, its position above the Hawaiian hotspot, and its chain of islands ageing steadily from Hawai'i Island in the southeast to Kaua'i in the northwest are geological facts entirely independent of anything tested in this document, and are not read here as supporting evidence for the coordinate result.

THE ORIENTATION

A Line Drawn From Giza

Hawai'i's geographic centre sits east of Giza, at a WGS84 distance of 8,941 miles (14,389 km), bearing 9.01° — among the northernmost bearings and the greatest distances of any control in the eleven-Area register.



This bearing and distance describe the state's geographic centre, tested independently of the Mauna Kea coordinate used on the Satellite and Gate pages. The two are related in geography but kept separate in method, and no numerical comparison between them is offered here.

THE MEASURED REGISTER

What the Numbers Establish

SOURCE RECORD

Key 215 identifies this Area as the Hawaiian Islands, registered as a field with a primary control at the state's official geographic centre.

COORDINATE SELECTION & PROVENANCE

Source precision: named. Map placement: field. The primary control (20.25°N, 156.33°W) is the state's official geographic centre; a secondary named-archipelago point is tested alongside it for sensitivity.

THE LONGITUDE TEST

The primary control's eastward longitude test from Giza returns a signed residual of +1.000 arcminute, at a WGS84 distance of 8,941 miles (14,389 km), bearing 9.01°.

THE LATITUDE DIAGNOSTIC

Under the declared modern-Giza latitude phase, the 7.5' test returns a signed north–south displacement of +1.428 miles.

RESEARCH FINDING & EVIDENTIAL LIMIT

Two independent controls — the official geographic centre and a secondary named-feature sensitivity point — return closely matching results, which Book I treats as a stronger registration than either alone. The finding concerns this Time Warp test specifically; no coordinate from the separate Satellite or Gate architectures is folded into it.

THE WORK OF ALIGNMENT

What Continues After the Coordinate Is Set

THE NATURE OF THE FIELD

The Hawaiian Islands are tested as an extended archipelago field, not a single peak. The geographic-centre control is a reproducible convention useful for calculation, not a claim about where any field's true centre of gravity lies.

CONTINUAL ACTIVATION, NOT RESIDENCE

Whatever is already carried by the Satellite and Gate registrations elsewhere on this ground, the Time Warp Area's own work is the same as every other Area in this Wheel: ongoing attention and alignment, not a call to permanent settlement layered on top of what is already there.

THE RHYTHM OF RETURN

Given Hawai'i's accessibility relative to several other Areas in this register, more frequent visitation may prove practical here than the working annual minimum — though the same underlying principle holds: continuing attention, not permanent residence, is what sustains the activation.

WHO TENDS THIS WORK

As with every Area in this Wheel, the ongoing alignment is carried as part of the Brotherhood of Light's wider custodianship — here, alongside whatever separate custodianship already attends the Satellite and Gate registrations on the same ground.

THE ONTOLOGICAL GROUND

One Ground, Three Independent Readings

Book I is careful about what it does and does not claim here. That Hawai'i carries a Sun Disc Satellite, an Ascension Gate, and now a tested Time Warp Area control is a genuinely notable convergence of three separately maintained systems on one archipelago — but it is reported as exactly that, a convergence, not folded into a single unified claim that would blur the boundaries each system was built to keep.

The deeper ontological weight of this ground, where it exists, belongs to the Satellite and Gate pages, which draw on Hawaiian cosmology directly. This document's contribution is narrower and more technical: an independent geodetic test, on its own terms, that happens to land on ground already carrying significance by two other measures entirely.



A REGISTRATION, NOT A RESIDENCE

None of this replaces the work of alignment itself. An Artificial Time Warp Area is not a settlement and not a shrine — it is a coordinate already at work, quietly, holding its place in a field that reaches further than any single visit could.

Whatever draws attention here — the rare convergence of three independent systems on one archipelago, or the discipline of testing each one separately rather than assuming they confirm each other — the same invitation extends: read each register on its own terms, and let the convergence, where it holds, speak for itself.

*Come see if the ground confirms it,
the way a measured line confirms itself—
not by being believed, but by being checked.*

Specifications & Coordinates

Area V of the Artificial Time Warp Wheel · Hawai'i, United States — the registered control at the state's official geographic centre.

THE CONTROL — HAWAI'I GEOGRAPHIC CENTRE

20.2500° N, 156.3300° W · Source precision: Named · Map placement: Field

Official state geographic centre, offshore of Maui. A secondary named-archipelago point is tested alongside it as a sensitivity check.

HURTAK LONGITUDE TEST

Eastward setting-out from Giza (31.15°E) returns a signed residual of +1.000 arcminute at the primary control.

LATITUDE DIAGNOSTIC (7.5' TEST)

Under the declared modern-Giza latitude phase: signed north–south displacement of +1.428 miles.

METHODOLOGICAL STATUS

Tested independently of the Satellite I and Base/Root Gate coordinates registered elsewhere on this ground. No coordinate from those separate architectures is imported into this Hurtak test.

RELATION TO GIZA

Bearing 9.0° from the Great Pyramid, Giza · 8,941 miles (14,389 km)

WGS84 geodesic bearing and distance computed from the Giza reference point (29.9792° N, 31.1342° E) to the control coordinate given above.

Note: this document offers registration, not survey. The coordinate above marks the state geographic centre per the primary control; vertical extent, magnetic orientation and field boundary remain open research questions in Book I.
