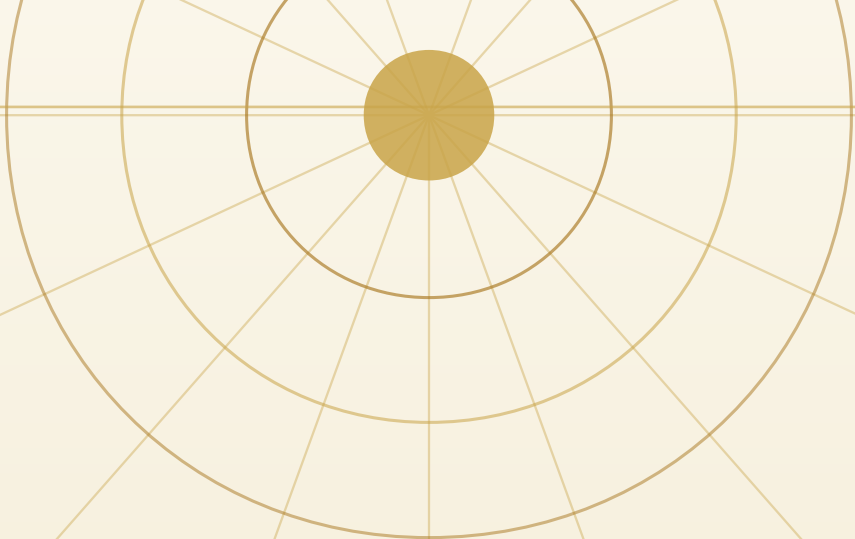




AREA VI OF ELEVEN · A RESULT REPORTED WITHOUT ADJUSTMENT

Still Water Held Inside Old-Growth Forest, at the Pacific Northwest's Outer Edge

A Result Kept Exactly as Measured

Not every control in this register returns a tight number, and Area Six is where that honesty is most visible: Vancouver Island's longitude test returns one of the larger residuals in the eleven-Area set, roughly three arcminutes — and Book I preserves that result without adjustment, exactly as it preserves every tighter result elsewhere.

This is what the Thesis calls, in its own working language, the Precision Lock: the same method applied identically whether the outcome is visually impressive or not. A study that only reported its close results would not be a study at all. Area Six is the register keeping its own promise.

None of that makes Vancouver Island's registration meaningless — a three-arcminute residual still sits within the range Book I's own expectations allow for a genuine test — but it is reported here with exactly the same plainness as every closer result, neither inflated nor apologised for.

THE LAND ITSELF

Old Growth Above a Still Lake

Vancouver Island carries some of the last extensive old-growth temperate rainforest on the Pacific coast — towering Douglas fir and western red cedar, some more than eight hundred years old, standing over mountain lakes so still they mirror the canopy whole. Strathcona, the province's oldest provincial park, sits near the island's geographic heart.

The circle the Wheel gives this Area — a quiet lake held inside dense conifer forest — reads as Pacific Northwest coastal-forest character generally, standing in for the island rather than any single named lake within it.

The island's official geographic centre, used as this Area's control, sits inland within that same old-growth belt — a cartographic convention rather than a named landmark, chosen for its reproducibility rather than any claimed significance of its own.

THE ORIENTATION

A Line Drawn From Giza

Vancouver Island's official centre sits northwest of Giza, at a WGS84 distance of 6,769 miles (10,894 km), bearing 345.11°.



An earlier working map point for this Area was superseded by the island's official geographic centre once that record became available, and is retained in Book I only as a documented sensitivity control, not as an alternative result.

THE MEASURED REGISTER

What the Numbers Establish

SOURCE RECORD

Key 215 identifies this Area as Vancouver Island, registered as a field with its control at the island's official geographic centre.

COORDINATE SELECTION & PROVENANCE

Source precision: named. Map placement: field. The control (49.63°N, 125.70°W) is drawn from BC Geographical Names' official island-centre record.

THE LONGITUDE TEST

The eastward setting-out from Giza returns a signed residual of -3.000 arcminutes — one of the larger principal residuals in the register — at a WGS84 distance of 6,769 miles (10,894 km), bearing 345.11° .

THE LATITUDE DIAGNOSTIC

Under the declared modern-Giza latitude phase, the 7.5' test returns a signed north–south displacement of +1.992 miles.

RESEARCH FINDING & EVIDENTIAL LIMIT

A three-arcminute residual sits at the outer edge of Book I's own expected range and is reported without adjustment or special pleading. The registration stands on the same evidentiary footing as every tighter result in this Wheel — neither strengthened nor weakened by how it compares to its neighbours.

THE WORK OF ALIGNMENT

What Continues After the Coordinate Is Set

THE NATURE OF THE FIELD

Vancouver Island's field is registered at the scale of the island itself, its official centre serving as a reproducible test point within old-growth forest rather than a claimed centre of any specific energetic structure.

CONTINUAL ACTIVATION, NOT RESIDENCE

Nothing in this registration calls for settlement inside protected old-growth forest, nor would that be appropriate. The activation and attention this Area asks for is the same ongoing work carried at every Area in the Wheel — entirely compatible with the island's existing conservation status.

THE RHYTHM OF RETURN

Where travel to this Area is genuinely possible, periodic visitation in these early years — annual, where practical — appears sufficient to hold the activation, consistent with the working observation applied across the Wheel.

WHO TENDS THIS WORK

As with every Area in this Wheel, the ongoing alignment is carried as part of the Brotherhood of Light's wider custodianship, not a new task assigned to any individual seeker.

What a Weaker Number Still Establishes

No esoteric lineage specific to this coordinate is claimed in Book I's record. What Area Six offers the wider study is methodological rather than mythological: proof, in the plainest sense, that the register was not built by selectively keeping only its tightest results. A three-arcminute residual, reported here exactly as measured, is what gives every other result in this Wheel its credibility.

There is something fitting in that discipline landing on ground defined by some of the oldest living trees on the continent — growth measured in centuries, held to account by a method that refuses to round its own numbers in either direction.



A REGISTRATION, NOT A RESIDENCE

None of this replaces the work of alignment itself. An Artificial Time Warp Area is not a settlement and not a shrine — it is a coordinate already at work, quietly, holding its place in a field that reaches further than any single visit could.

Whatever draws attention here — ancient forest holding still water, or a result reported honestly even when it is not the register's strongest — the same discipline applies: the number stands as measured, and the ground is offered as it is, not as it might be dressed up to seem.

*Come see if the ground confirms it,
the way a measured line confirms itself—
not by being believed, but by being checked.*

Specifications & Coordinates

Area VI of the Artificial Time Warp Wheel · Vancouver Island, British Columbia, Canada — the registered control at the island's official geographic centre.

THE CONTROL — VANCOUVER ISLAND CENTRE

49.6300° N, 125.7000° W · Source precision: Named · Map placement: Field

Official geographic centre of Vancouver Island, British Columbia (BC Geographical Names).

HURTAK LONGITUDE TEST

Eastward setting-out from Giza (31.15°E) returns a signed residual of −3.000 arcminutes at the island centre control.

LATITUDE DIAGNOSTIC (7.5' TEST)

Under the declared modern-Giza latitude phase: signed north–south displacement of +1.992 miles.

METHODOLOGICAL STATUS

One of the larger principal longitude residuals in the register, preserved without adjustment. An earlier working map point is retained only as a superseded sensitivity control.

RELATION TO GIZA

Bearing 345.1° from the Great Pyramid, Giza · 6,769 miles (10,894 km)

WGS84 geodesic bearing and distance computed from the Giza reference point (29.9792° N, 31.1342° E) to the control coordinate given above.

Note: this document offers registration, not survey. The coordinate above marks the official island-centre control; vertical extent, magnetic orientation and field boundary remain open research questions in Book I.
